THE GAME

The two-time defending MEAC champion Pirates (6-10, 3-0 MEAC), winners of four straight, will return to the HU Convocation Center on Monday, setting up for a nationally-televised match-up against North Carolina Central (11-6, 2-1 MEAC) at 7 p.m.

MULTIMEDIA

The game will be broadcast live on ESPNU and WHOV 88.1 FM.

THE SERIES

The Pirates are 1-4 against North Carolina Central, picking up their first win in the series last season, 80-79 in Durham, N.C. The Eagles have visited the HU Convocation Center three times since beginning the transition into the MEAC in 2011-12, going 3-0 in those contests.

PIRATES AGAINST THE MID-EASTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

Since joining Div. I in 1995-96, the Pirates are 254-141 against schools currently in the MEAC, going 21-11 against Bethune-Cookman, 18-18 against Coppin State, 24-18 against Delaware State, 22-11 against Florida A&M, 37-5 against Howard, 26-7 against Maryland Eastern Shore, 29-14 against Morgan State, 23-21 against Norfolk State, 24-11 against North Carolina A&T, 1-4 against North Carolina Central, 8-2 against Savannah State, and 21-19 against South Carolina State. Hampton is the two-time defending MEAC champion, and the Pirates have won six MEAC Tournament crowns: 2001, 2002, 2006, 2011, 2015, and 2016.

CHIEVOUS' LATE LAYUP LIFTS PIRATES PAST NC CENTRAL

DURHAM, N.C. – Quinton Chievious banked a layup off the glass with two seconds left Monday night at McDougald-McLendon Arena, lifting the Hampton University men's basketball team to an 80-79 win over North Carolina Central.

In picking up their fifth straight win, the Pirates improved to 10-7 overall and 6-0 in MEAC play.

Reginald Johnson, Jr., the reigning MEAC Player of the Week, led the Pirates with 27 points on 7-for-15 shooting – going 4-for-8 from behind the arc and a perfect 9-for-9 at the free throw line. He also had seven rebounds and seven assists.

Chievious, the hero late, went 8-for-11 from the floor, scoring 19 points and grabbing a team-high eight rebounds. Lawrence Cooks came off the bench to chip in 13 points, all in the second half.

Jervon Pressley grabbed five rebounds and blocked three shots in 16 minutes of action.

The Pirates shot 43.6 percent (24-for-55) from the floor, despite shooting 39.3 percent (11-for-28) in the second half. Hampton was 8-for-21 (38.1 percent) from behind the arc, 24-for-33 (72.7 percent) from the free throw line, and out-rebounded NCCU 34-28.

Dante Holmes gave NCCU a 79-78 lead with a 3-pointer with 27 seconds remaining. Johnson had a look on the ensuing possession to give the Pirates the lead, but the Eagles came away with the rebound, forcing the Pirates to foul.

But Dajuan Graf missed both free throws with nine seconds left. Johnson drew two defenders to the wing on the Pirates' next possession before feeding the ball to Chievious underneath the basket. He banked in the layup to give the Pirates the lead, before Brian Darden stole the ensuing in-bounds pass.

Though Darden's momentum carried him out of bounds, giving possession back to NCCU, the Eagles didn't have enough time to mount anything.

The Pirates picked up their first win over NCCU since the Eagles joined the MEAC.

The Pirates were in control throughout much of the first half – at one point holding a 15-point lead – before taking a 45-37 lead into the intermission. Johnson had 19 points in the first half alone, going 5-for-8 from the floor and 3-for-5 from distance, while Chievious had 10 points at the break.

But after Dionte Adams hit two free throws to put Hampton on top 49-39 in the opening moments of the second half, the Eagles made their first run of the night, going on a 13-2 spurt to take a 52-51 lead at the 15:07 mark following a Patrick Cole layup.

That was NCCU's first lead since an alley-oop on the game's opening possession.

are 56-34 at home – including a 9-2 mark in the HU Convocation Center last season. That was the team's best home record under Joyner, though the Pirates did go 9-3 at home in 2013-14 and 8-3 in the Convocation Center in 2010-11 – a season in which Hampton won 24 games and made it to the NCAA Tournament. Hampton dropped its home opener on Nov. 11, falling 67-56 to Rider, before defeating Chowan 70-69 in overtime on Nov. 17, defeating William & Mary 79-69 on Dec. 3, falling 86-79 to Winthrop on Dec. 17, defeating Coker 94-69 on Dec. 30, defeating North Carolina A&T 68-53 on Jan. 4, and beating Savannah State 84-80 on Jan. 9.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

North Carolina Central, in its eighth season under head coach LeVelle Moton, has won back-to-back games after Saturday's 72-57 win at Norfolk State. Redshirt senior guard Patrick Cole leads three players in double figures, averaging 18.8 points per game (fourth in the MEAC) to go along with his 7.1 rebounds per contest. Redshirt senior guard Dajuan Graf is second on the team and 10th in the MEAC with 14.7 points per game, while redshirt senior guard Rashaun Madison is averaging 11.2 points per game. The Eagles lead the MEAC in scoring defense (64.4 ppg) and rank second in scoring offense (74.1 ppg).

LAST TIME OUT

The Pirates have won four straight games after Saturday's 85-77 overtime win over Delaware State to remain unbeaten in MEAC play. Jermaine Marrow led four Pirates in double figures with 23 points and a career-high six assists, while Lysander Bracey notched a career-high 19 points. Lawrence Cooks added 18 points and four assists, while Charles Wilson-Fisher came off the bench to drop 10 points and grab a team-high nine rebounds.

PIRATES PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

Despite winning back-to-back MEAC titles, the Pirates were picked to finish third in the conference this season in a poll conducted by the league's head coaches and sports information directors. Hampton, which returns just one starter from last season, picked up two first-place votes and racked up 250 points in the poll. Howard was tabbed the preseason favorite, while South Carolina State – which fell to the Pirates in last season's MEAC Tournament championship game – was picked to finish second.

COOKS THE ONLY ONE

Lawrence Cooks is the lone returning starter for the Pirates, and he comes into 2016-17 as the team's top returner in scoring (7.8 ppg), rebounding (3.7 rpg), assists (47), and steals (19). He is also the only player on this year's team that isn't a freshman, sophomore, or junior – though he does have two MEAC championship rings and NCAA Tournament appearances to his credit. Cooks dropped a career-high 22 points at Winthrop last season, a campaign in which he scored in double figures 11 times. Cooks had 10 points in Hampton's season opener against Rider, and he dropped a career-high 23 points

against William & Mary. Cooks, who is second on the team in scoring with 12.6 points per game, dropped 21 at Appalachian State.

WILSON-FISHER LOOKING FOR A BIGGER ROLE

Charles Wilson-Fisher was a key role player in the Pirates' run through the MEAC Tournament in 2015, and he was a key reserve down low for the Pirates last season. 2016-17 could figure to be a breakout season for the Los Angeles native with the graduation of Jer-von Pressley, and Wilson-Fisher will be looking to improve on his scoring and rebounding averages (2.7 and 2.5, respectively) this season. He tied his then-career high in points with 10 last season against Northern Arizona, and against Rider, he set a new career high in rebounds (15). Wilson-Fisher set new career highs in points (16) and blocks (four) this past Monday against Savannah State.

STRONG START FOR MARROW

Sixteen games into his collegiate career, freshman Jermaine Marrow leads the Pirates and ranks seventh in the MEAC in scoring, averaging 15.5 points per game. He opened his career with 13 points against Rider, before dropping 11 points on Nov. 17 in an overtime win over Chowan and then scoring 15 points at Kansas State and dropping 16 at Richmond. He dropped 25 points against Stony Brook and Savannah State, and a career-high 27 points against William & Mary, and Marrow has scored in double figures in 15 of his first 16 games. The Heritage High graduate from nearby Newport News, Va. was 4A East State Player of the Year last season, proving to be one of Virginia's best scorers – averaging over 25 points a game in 2015-16.

ASTROTH MAKING AN IMPACT

AJ Astroth was key in Hampton's win over Chowan on Nov. 17 – not just because he poured in a season-high 18 points and nine rebounds in just his second game with the program, but because it was his layup in the closing moments that gave the Pirates the lead. Astroth is fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 6.7 points per game, and he grabbed a season-high 12 rebounds at East Carolina. His 6.1 boards a night are the team's best, and sixth in the MEAC, after his first double-double of the season (16 points, 15 rebounds) at Gardner-Webb.

BRACEY HEATING UP

Lysander Bracey has scored in double figures in three of the Pirates' last four games – including a career-high 19 points in Saturday's overtime win at Delaware State. He also had four assists in that contest, tying the season high he set against Savannah State. Bracey also scored 12 points in back-to-back games against Coker and North Carolina A&T, and he is averaging 12.0 points per game in MEAC play, going 12-for-28 (.429) from the floor.

LOTS OF YOUTH

Of the 15 players listed on this season's roster, 11 are listed as either a freshman or sophomore. In fact, there are eight sophomores on this year's Pirates squad – including Branden Aughtburns, Trevond Barnes, Kalin Fisher, Imani Miller, Akim Mitchell, and Devon Oakley, who were all role players on last year's championship team.

STAFF CHANGES

While Edward Joyner Jr. is back for his eighth season as head coach, his staff will have a different look in 2016-17. Darryl Sharp will now serve as Associate Head Coach, while Matthew Hamilton has been moved from Director of Basketball Operations to assistant coach. In addition, Brian Graves, who had previously served as the head coach at Bryant & Stratton College, has joined the staff as an assistant coach.

PIRATES IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Since moving up to NCAA Division I competition in 1995, the Pirates have made six trips to the NCAA Tournament – including each of the last two. Prior to the 2014-15 season,

the most recent trip was in 2011, when Hampton fell 87-45 in the second round to top-seeded Duke. The 2014-15 season not only marked the program's fifth all-time appearance in the NCAA Div. I Tournament, it also marks the team's second win in the event, thanks to a 74-64 first-round win over Manhattan in the First Four.

Prior to 2011, the Pirates were last in the NCAA Tournament in 2006, when the Pirates fell 71-49 to Monmouth in the opening-round game in Dayton, Ohio.

Hampton's most famous trip to the NCAA Div. I Men's Basketball Tournament is also its first; in 2001, the MEAC champion Pirates, coached by Steve Merfeld, upended No. 2 seed Iowa State 58-57 in Boise, Idaho on a 4-footer from Tarvis Williams with 6.9 seconds left to play. Williams led the Pirates (25-6) with 16 points and 13 rebounds that afternoon, while Marseilles Brown added 14 points and LaSean Howard poured in 10 points.

Williams' bucket not only gave Hampton a win for the ages – and marked just the fourth time in tournament history a No. 15 seed had defeated a No. 2 seed – but it also provided one of the tournament's most vivid images: Merfeld, lifted into the air by David Johnson, fists and feet raised into the air.

The Pirates would fall in the second round that year to Georgetown 76-57.

Hampton also made the NCAA Tournament in 2002, falling 78-67 as a No. 15 seed to No. 2 Connecticut in the first round of the East Regional.

NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL HEAD COACH LeVELLE MOTON

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from assistant coach to the position of head coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history.

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14-seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regular-season conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona). Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the Boxtorow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. In fact, the program experienced only two losses in the calendar year of 2013. The 22 victories were the most since his freshman year of 1992-93 when NCCU finished 26-4. The 11-game winning streak was the longest since the 1995-96 campaign when NCCU won 16-in-a-row. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year of Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of the NCCU basketball program, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level. Of the 215 schools that have reclassified to the NCAA Division I level, NCCU was one of 38 schools across the nation who finished their first official season with 17 wins or more. That puts the Eagles in the same company as (Air Force-1958, VCU-1974, Weber State-1964, George Mason-1979, UNLV-1970, James Madison-1977, and Northwestern State (La.)-1997) who also recorded 17 wins in its inaugural campaign.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. His record against MEAC opponents during the regular season was 10-5 which would have placed the maroon and gray as the number two seed in the league tournament. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

Year No. 1 was certainly a challenging one for Moton, but the program took numerous steps in the right direction. During the 2009-10 campaign, Moton led NCCU to its first winning record at home (7-4), it's first Division I winning streak (three games), and gave numerous big-time opponents trouble throughout the season, but the second year head coach is nowhere near satisfied.

The Eagles finished 7-22, which included wins against soon-to-be conference foes Maryland Eastern Shore and Savannah State. The seven victories represented the most since making

the move to Division I.

2016-17 PIRATES AT A GLANCE

The Hampton University men's basketball team is the two-time defending Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) champions; in each of the past two seasons, the Pirates have been the conference's representative on the sport's biggest stage. As the team continued racking up wins and bulldozing its way through the MEAC Tournament – scoring 80 points or more in each of the three games – the accolades kept coming.

But once the season ended, reality set in. Coming into 2016-17, head coach Edward "Buck" Joyner Jr. – entering his eighth season – finds himself with a roster that lost four starters and six letterwinners from a year ago. Among the losses? MEAC Male Student-Athlete of the Year Reginald Johnson Jr. and double-double machine Quinton Chievous. Both players were First Team All-Conference players a year ago.

Three-point specialist Brian Darden and post player Jervon Pressley have also moved on, as did key reserve Dionte Adams and Gregory Hayden. Three of the four starters lost averaged double figures in points last season.

So Joyner comes into 2016-17 with a roster that includes 11 underclassmen – and a new-look coaching staff. Darryl Sharp returns to the staff, serving as associate head coach, while Matt Hamilton has been moved up to assistant coach and Brian Graves joins the program after coaching at Bryant & Stratton.

Returners

Guard Lawrence Cooks is the top returning scorer – and the only player who is not a freshman, sophomore, or junior – for the Pirates. He averaged just under eight points a contest last season, and is also Hampton's top returner in rebounding (3.7 rpg), assists (47), and steals (19). He started in 21 games last season, scoring in double figures 11 times and recording a double-double (12 points, 13 rebounds) against Washington Adventist.

His career high in points – 22 – came in the season opener at Winthrop.

The most experienced returner – next to Cooks – is post player Charles Wilson-Fisher. After making four starts in 32 games last season, Wilson-Fisher has played in 51 career games at Hampton. Last season, Wilson-Fisher averaged 2.7 points and 2.5 rebounds in a reserve role last season, and he is the team's top returning shot blocker.

Wilson-Fisher, who tied his career high in points with 10 at Northern Arizona, did shoot 48 percent from the floor and 70 percent from the free throw line last season.

Among the Pirates' other nine returners, many will be looking at increased roles in relation to last season. Guards Kalin Fisher, Imani Miller, Akim Mitchell, and Devin Oakley will give the Pirates some depth in the backcourt. Fisher saw the most action of the four last season, averaging 12.6 minutes per game and pouring in just under four points a game.

Mitchell, who averaged nearly 11 minutes a game in 2015-16, was 80 percent from the free throw line.

Donald Ralls Jr. will also return for the Pirates; last season, he was on the back end of the proverbial depth chart along with Miller and Oakley. All three are likely to have larger roles this season, with the departures of Chievous, Johnson, and Darden.

In the frontcourt, the Pirates figure to receive larger contributions from Trevond Barnes and Branden Aughtburns. With Pressley and Adams gone, Barnes and Aughtburns now find themselves behind only Wilson-Fisher in the hierarchy of the frontcourt.

Barnes averaged six minutes a game last season, averaging 1.3 points and 1.4 rebounds a game, while Aughtburns saw action in 12 games.

Newcomers

Six players will be making their debuts in the blue and white this season for the Pirates – including local products Austin Colbert and Jermaine Marrow. Colbert, from nearby Chesapeake, Va., is a transfer from Old Dominion, while Marrow will join the program from Heritage High in Newport News.

Colbert, who will bring Div. I experience to the frontcourt, sat out the 2015-16 season for the Monarchs after transferring there from the University of Illinois. He was with the Illini for two seasons, and in 2014-15, Colbert averaged 1.7 points and 2.2 rebounds per contest.

In two seasons at Illinois, Colbert shot just under 53 percent from the floor.

Marrow was named the Daily Press' boys basketball Player of the Year this past April after averaging more than 30 points a game and leading the Hurricanes to the quarterfinals of the state tournament. In his first two games with Heritage last season, Marrow dropped 47 and 46 points, respectively.

And he did that while transitioning from shooting guard to point guard.

The Pirates will also welcome in guards Lysander Bracey and Jaekwon Carlyle – the former transferred to Hampton from Brunswick Community College, while the latter comes to the Pirates from Imhotep Charter School in Philadelphia, Pa.

Bracey averaged over 17 points a game for Brunswick last season, hitting nearly 40 percent of his 3-pointers.

Swing player Trey Carver also comes to Hampton from nearby Elizabeth City, N.C., where he averaged 18.5 points and nearly six rebounds for Northeastern High this past season. As a junior Carver averaged 18.5 points and 7.5 rebounds a game.

He grabbed 8.6 boards a contest as a sophomore.

Post player Rasheed Stanley, a 7-foot, 295-pound redshirt sophomore from Atlanta, Ga., will also join the team this season.

Schedule

Hampton's 2016-17 slate includes five non-conference home games – including the first two games of the year. The Pirates open the season against Rider (Nov. 11) and Chowan (Nov. 17) – before hitting the road to take on Kansas State on Nov. 20 and Richmond on Nov. 22.

After competing in the Barclays Classic against the likes of Robert Morris, Stony Brook, and Towson, the Pirates will head to Greenville, N.C. on Nov. 29 to take on East Carolina – before returning home on Dec. 3 to take on local rival William & Mary.

A Dec. 7 game at Gardner-Webb will lead the Pirates into fall finals – after which, they will return to the Convocation Center to face Winthrop on Dec. 17. A Dec. 21 tilt at Appalachian State will wrap up the pre-Christmas portion of the schedule.

On Dec. 28, the Pirates will play at Princeton, before returning home on Dec. 30 to take on Coker College.

The Coker game will kick off a four-game homestand that will also see the Pirates square off against North Carolina A&T (Jan. 4), South Carolina State (Jan. 7), and Savannah State (Jan. 9). Hampton will also have home MEAC games against North Carolina Central (Jan. 16), Coppin State (Jan. 30), Maryland Eastern Shore (Feb. 1), Howard (Feb. 11), and Norfolk State (Feb. 27).

Road MEAC games include Delaware State (Jan. 14), Norfolk State (Jan. 21), Savannah State (Feb. 4), South Carolina State (Feb. 6), Bethune-Cookman (Feb. 18), Florida A&M (Feb. 20), Morgan State (Feb. 25), and Coppin State (March 3).

The 2017 MEAC Tournament will be held March 7-12 in the Norfolk Scope Arena.

In his first seven seasons as head men's basketball coach at Hampton University, Edward "Buck" Joyner Jr. has guided the Pirates to national prominence on more than one occasion – and that's not even counting the magical run Hampton made in March 2015 en route to an improbable MEAC championship, an NCAA Tournament win, and national notoriety.

This past season, Joyner guided the Pirates to a 21-11 overall record – their second 20-win season under his tutelage – and won the MEAC regular season title with a mark of 13-3 before defending the conference tournament championship. The Pirates again earned the MEAC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 16 seed in the Midwest Region and taking on Virginia.

Hampton won its first MEAC regular-season crown since the 2001-02 season.

Along the way, guards Quinton Chievous and Reginald Johnson, Jr. were First Team All-MEAC honorees. Both players ranked top four in the conference in scoring, and Chievous – one of only a handful of players nationally to average a double-double – led the MEAC in overall rebounding, offensive rebounds, and defensive rebounds.

Johnson was also named the MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Player, averaging 19.3 points and 8.3 assists per contest in those three games. He tied a MEAC Tournament record with 13 assists in the quarterfinals against Morgan State.

Chievous was also named to the MEAC's All-Tournament Team.

With a 61-48 win at American on Nov. 17, 2015, Joyner picked up his 100th career win as a head coach. His 120 wins are the most among Div. I coaches in program history, and Joyner is third overall in terms of career wins, 20 wins shy of Malcolm Avery (140 wins, 1987-95).

Despite going 8-8 in MEAC play in 2014-15 and winding up with a No. 6 seed, the Pirates went on to win four games in six days in the conference tournament, taking their second MEAC Tournament crown under Joyner with an 82-61 win over Delaware State in the title game.

In claiming the MEAC crown, the Pirates upset the No. 3, No. 2, and No. 5 seeds.

The Pirates then wound up in the NCAA First Four in Dayton, Ohio to take on Manhattan. Hampton won that game 74-64 for the second NCAA Tournament win for

the program at the Div. I level – and the first since the 2001 upset over Iowa State – before taking on No. 1 seed Kentucky in the second round.

The win gave the Pirates an unprecedented level of national exposure – exposure helped by a press conference soundbite from Joyner that went viral and made Hampton tournament darlings leading up to its second-round contest against Kentucky.

Overall, Hampton has made four postseason appearances under Joyner; in addition to NCAA appearances the past two seasons and in 2011, the Pirates competed in the College Basketball Insider (CBI) Tournament in 2014.

Joyner became the program's all-time winningest Div. I coach on Feb. 7, 2015 with a 64-61 win over Maryland Eastern Shore, surpassing Steve Merfeld (90 wins) on the program's all-time wins list.

Along the way, Deron Powers was named the MEAC Tournament Most Outstanding Player – after earning Third Team All-MEAC honors – and Reginald Johnson was named to the All-Tournament Team.

With the help of associate head coach Akeem Miskdeen, Joyner instilled a new philosophy leading into the 2013-14 season. Faced with a young but talented team, Joyner is looking to instill a philosophy of discipline, toughness, and passion (DTP) in the Pirates.

In discipline – getting players to do things the right way every time on and off the court – Joyner quotes Aristotle: "We are what we repeatedly do. Excellence is not just an act; it's a habit." Nothing great, according to Joyner, is ever accomplished without discipline.

By giving the Pirates toughness, Joyner and his staff hope they will be able to withstand great strain without tearing or breaking. The Pirates will have to be tough, fighting through adversity – physical, mental, and emotional – on and off the court.

By instilling passion, Joyner and his staff want the Pirates to embrace being student-athletes, in every sense of the term. If the players truly love what they do, that passion will make being disciplined and tough easier.

Through DTP, Joyner wants a team that plays hard, unselfishly, with confidence, and with passion – believing that builds the foundation of a successful basketball program. The Pirates, through DTP, should take the simple game of basketball and play it aggressively, while simultaneously reaching their full potential on and off the court and never losing sight of their goals.

Joyner also hopes DTP will be a good tool for teaching important life lessons.

The Pirates won 18 games in 2013-14, finishing second in

the MEAC with a mark of 13-3. Despite falling in the quarterfinals to Coppin State, Hampton made its second postseason appearance under Joyner, competing at Penn State in the first round of the CBI Tournament.

The Pirates ended the regular season on a seven-game winning streak, a stretch that included season sweeps over rivals Howard and Norfolk State. As a head coach, Joyner is 9-1 overall against Howard and 6-6 against Norfolk State.

Along the way, senior forward Du'Vaughn Maxwell was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Year, leading the conference with 3.2 blocked shots per contest and ranking third in the MEAC in rebounding with 7.5 a game.

Maxwell was also a First Team All-MEAC selection.

In Joyner's fourth season with the Pirates, Hampton went 14-17 overall in 2012-13. However, the Pirates went 11-5 in conference play, finishing third in the MEAC after winning a head-to-head tiebreaker over Savannah State. Hampton closed out the regular season with nine wins in its last 12 games, as a young squad began to mesh and show its potential.

Leading that charge was freshman point guard Deron Powers, who was named the MEAC Rookie of the Year after leading the Pirates in both scoring and assists last season. Powers was second in the MEAC in free throw percentage and fourth in assists.

Powers was also named a Mid-Major Freshman All-American by CollegeInsider.com.

The Pirates struggled to a 12-21 record in 2011-12, though Hampton did advance to the semifinals of the MEAC Tournament in trying to defend their 2010-11 crown. Along the way, the Pirates upset No. 1 seed Savannah State in the quarterfinal round 59-46. That win was also the 50th in Joyner's young coaching career.

Darrion Pellum, who was a senior in 2011-12, led the team and the MEAC in scoring, earning First Team All-MEAC honors after averaging 18.3 points per game. Pellum was also named VaSID First Team All-State.

Joyner led the Pirates to the 2011 MEAC Tournament championship in his second season, guiding Hampton to a 24-9 record – marking the first time the Pirates won 20 games since the 2001-02 season. The Pirates were the No. 2 seed in the MEAC Tournament, defeating Morgan State 60-55 in the championship game to win the tournament and win the automatic NCAA bid for the first time since 2006.

Hampton earned a No. 16 seed, facing top-seeded Duke in the first round.

Joyner saw two of his athletes earn All-MEAC honors, as Pellum was named First Team All-MEAC after finishing the season second in the conference in scoring and junior guard Kwame Morgan was named Second Team All-MEAC after

a breakout season. Pellum, the MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Player, was also named VaSID Second Team All-State, BASN HBCU Second Team All-American and NABC All-District 15, while Morgan was named a Lou Henson All-American and NABC All-District 15.

Joyner was also named BASN HBCU Coach of the Year for his efforts.

The Pirates overcame offseason tragedy and went 14-18 in 2009-10, Joyner's first season as head coach, finishing tied for fifth in the MEAC with an 8-8 record. He led the Pirates to the MEAC Tournament semifinals, beating archrival Norfolk State in the quarterfinals 73-70. Despite struggling to find consistency for much of the season, Hampton won six straight games to close out the regular season and open the MEAC Tournament, before falling to top seed Morgan State 74-67 in the semifinals.

Senior guard Vincent Simpson earned Second Team All-MEAC honors for the second straight year under Joyner, leading the team with 14.1 points per game. Both Simpson and senior forward Michael Freeman eclipsed the 1,000 career point mark in 2009-10.

As an assistant coach, he helped develop such players as Simpson, first team all-conference guard Rashad West, the MEAC's leading scorer in 2006, and Michael Freeman, the 2006 MEAC Rookie of the Year. As academic coordinator, Joyner guided the men's basketball program to the highest team GPA in 10 years.

Joyner came to Hampton after 11 years as the assistant head coach at Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte, N.C. He also served as the lead assistant coach on the women's basketball team in the last five years of his tenure at Johnson C. Smith. Joyner also served as assistant to the Dean of Students over judiciary affairs.

Joyner played his collegiate ball at Johnson C. Smith, earning letters all four seasons he played. He helped guide the Golden Bulls to three division titles, two trips to the CIAA championship game and three appearances in the NCAA Division II Tournament. Joyner was named Defensive Player of the Year twice, and he finished his career among the top-ten assist leaders in Johnson C. Smith history.

A native of Winston-Salem N.C., Joyner is the son of Edward Joyner Sr., former head basketball coach at St. Paul's College, and the nephew of Steve Joyner, the head basketball coach and athletic director at Johnson C. Smith.

Joyner received his Master's degree in sports administration from Hampton University in May 2016. He is married to the former Aerian Miller and they have three children: E.J., Andrew, and Layla.
