THE LAST TIME OUT - HAMPTON 70, CHARLESTON SO. 68 -- 12/22/20

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – A Russell Dean floater with 1.3 seconds left gave visiting Hampton a two-game sweep of its opening Big South Conference series with a 70-68 win at Charleston Southern on Tuesday night.

Hampton carried over its defensive pressure from the second half of Monday's 67-55 win by holding the hosts Buccaneers to 24.1% from the field (7-of-29) and racing to a 34-18 halftime lead on a Dean jumper with 34 seconds left in the half.

The lead grew to 20 points early in the second half on a 3-ball by Chris Shelton with 17 minutes left for a 41-21 lead. Charleston Southern caught its second wind and chipped away to take an eventual 59-58 lead off a Melvin Edwards, Jr. layup with 4:13 left.

Both teams traded buckets as Davion Warren hit a jumper and Phlandrous Flemming, Jr. drained a 3-ball for CSU to put them up 62-61 with 3:31 remaining. Hampton regained the lead on a pair of Warren free throws, along with one from Dean and a 3-ball from Shelton for a 66-62 advantage at the 2:23 mark.

A pair of Fleming buckets tied the game at 68 with 26 seconds left before Dean's floater in the lane with 1.3 seconds remaining.

Warren smashed his career high with 29 points, going a career best 11-of-12 from the line and adding eight rebounds. Dean also set a career-highs of 19 points and nine rebounds with five assists. Chris Shelton added nine points on 3-of-6 from behind the arc and Dajour Dickens chipped in with eight points and eight rebounds.

YOUNGSTERS ABOUND FOR PIRATES

While the Hampton roster does have three seniors listed, there is no one on the Pirates roster with more than a year of experience at Hampton. Four juniors (all transfers), four sophomores from last year's squad and three freshmen join the three seniors who all transferred in last year.

REPLACING SCORING LOAD

Hampton enters the 2020-21 season replacing 73.9% of its scoring load from the 2019-20 campaign. That total ranks 13th amongst NCAA Division I schools in highest percentage of points to replace.

DIMES BY DEUCE

Sophomore Russell (Deuce) Dean has taken charge of the point guard spot this year and is ranked in the top 20 nationally averaging 6.6 assists per game.

He had a career-high 10 assists at Norfolk State and dished out eight against Howard, William & Mary along with seven against VMI. Against Howard he had eight assists with no turnovers.

He doubled his previous career high scoring 18 points against William & Mary on Dec. 16, then topped on Dec, 22 at Charleston Southern with 19. His prior high was nine in both meetings with UNC Asheville last season.

GIMME THAT

Junior Dajour Dickens moved into the starting lineup at VMI and has come out swatting shots.

The 7-foot Hampton native blocked three shots in his first start and then blocked a career best six shots against William & Mary. In six games, Dickens has 16 blocked shots to lead the Big South averaging 2.67 per contest to rank 19th nationally.

WARREN AND HIS 20S

Senior Davion Warren had scored a career high 20 points on three occasions, prior to his 21-point outing against Howard on December 18. He did it first against Charleston Southern on Jan. 4, 2020, while he's hit 20 twice in the first four games this year. In the season opener he had 20 against George Washington and then added 20 against VMI.

In the last win at Charleston Southern, the senior from Buffalo went for 29 points in the 70-68 Hampton win.

He leads the team in scoring averaging 17.6 points per game.

SHELTON'S SHOTS RING TRUE

Sophomore Chris Shelton is making his case for a breakout star in 2020-21. The Louisa H.S. standout and Virginia Player of the Year is hitting 43.6% from 3-point range (24-of-55) through the first seven games. Inside the arc, he's 7-of-11 heading into the conference home opener. Shelton, whose father played at Ohio State and finished at VCU, is second on the team in scoring at 12.4 points per game.
