>>QUICK HITS

- This series marks just the sixth and seventh times the Bucs and the Davidson have faced off in program history, and the third and fourth times the teams have played in Charleston, S.C.
- The Catamounts have won three of the four contests in the Applin coaching era, including a 66-57 win last February in Hampton, Va.
- CSU returns nine players, including four starters from last season's team heading into the 2020-21 season.
- CSU welcomes five newcomers to the roster in 2020-21, including a trio of transfers and a pair of freshmen hailing from West Virginia.
- The Bucs played on three consecutive Wednesdays to open the 2020-21 season including the November 25 matchup against Columbia International.
- CSU was picked 10th overall in the 2020-21 Big South Conference Preseason Women's Basketball poll as announced at the conference media day.
- Applin named a trio of captains prior to the 2020-21 season with Anna Webster, Alyssia Faye, and Sha'Mya Leigh all being recognized in the leadership role by the Bucs coaching staff.
- The 2020-21 season marks Applin's ninth season in the leadership role at the helm with the Bucs reaching the conference semifinals in two of the last four years.



Carmella Walker recorded her second double-digit scoring game of the season against Western Carolina to take over the team's scoring lead (11.5).

>>TEAM NOTES

Series History

Hampton leads the all-time series over the Bucs, 3-2, courtesy of their three wins in the last four match-ups since joining the Big South Conference. The Pirates fell in the inaugural contest against the Buccaneers back in the 1995-96 season in Charleston, 83-82, but have taken three of the past four games over the last two years since joining the Big South as full members prior to the 2018-19 season.

Four of the five contests between the Bucs and the Pirates have been decided by less than double-digits, including both games last season between HU and CSU. CSU's win in February 2019 was the lone contest to see either team win by more than 10 points as the Buccaneers took the 72-57 victory thanks to four players scoring double-digits and a 25-point third quarter.

Hampton took both contests last season by a combined margin of 14 points as the Pirates took the contest in Charleston, 64-59, while toppling the Bucs at Hampton, 66-57. Both games were highlighted by dominant offensive stretches from the Pirates as Hampton went on a 12-0 run in the first game, while hitting 11 of their first 12 shots in the second contest.

Buccaneers utilize complete team effort in 66-56 win over Western Carolina

Charleston Southern took advantage of Carmella Walker's strong second quarter and solid shooting throughout the contest as the Buccaneers defeated Western Carolina in nonconference action on Sunday afternoon inside the Buccaneer Field House, 66-56.

Walker scored nine of her team-high 14 points in the second quarter as the senior guard went 2-of-3 from the floor and 5-of-7 from the line during the stretch in pacing the Bucs to a nine-point halftime lead over the Catamounts. Overall, the Bucs went 20-of-27 from the free throw line in the contest and shot 50.0% from the field on their way to holding on to the double-digit win over WCU.

Walker (14), Janaia Fargo (13), and Sha'Mya Leigh (11) all scored in double figures for the game as the Buccaneers led by as many as 11 in recording their second win in the all-time series against the Catamounts. Alyssia Faye added six rebounds and eight points, while Sharita Godfrey chipped in nine points and her fourth block of the season in the win.

Rutgers pulls away early in 94-45 win over Hampton

Rutgers seized control of the Friday afternoon game early over the visiting Hampton Pirates as the Scarlet Knights topped the Pirates,

94-45. Aided by a 15-point lead in the first quarter, Rutgers cruised to the win behind Arella Guirantes' 25-point, eight assist game.

Hampton was paced by Nylah Young's 17 points in the contest in the Pirates' second action of the 2020-21 season. Jermaine Mapp and Shawn Mills scored seven points apiece in the loss, while Alexis Wooden chipped in five rebounds overall.

The Pirates shot 28.6% from the floor as a team and 26.7% from the three-point line in the loss. Hampton also combined to shoot 61.9% (13-of-21) from the free throw line paced by Mapps' 4-for-4 performance.

Bucs against the Big South

No surprises when it comes to conference play for the Buccaneers as Charleston Southern has faced off with each Big South team on multiple occasions throughout the years. The inaugural matchup between the Bucs and a Big South opponent came back in the 1977-78 season when CSU fell to the Winthrop Eagles, 73-52.

As the newcomer to the group, the Bucs' history against Hampton is limited compared to the other Big South schools. The Bucs and Pirates have faced off against each other five times, while CSU's next smallest sample size versus opponents comes against USC Upstate (15 games played).

Charleston Southern was picked 10th overall in the conference's preseason poll as voted on by the coaches prior to the Big South Media Day. Hampton was selected fourth overall with Laren VanArsdale and Nylah Young both garnering preseason First Team All-Conference selections.

Make It Rain

Charleston Southern has been lights out on the offensive side of the ball this season as the Buccaneers lead the Big South Conference in three-point percentage, while sitting second overall in field goal percentage on the season. Overall as a team, the Bucs are shooting 42.6% from the floor as a unit, while hitting 37.0% from behind the arc on the year.

CSU ran out the same starting lineup for the fourth game of the 2020-21 season as the Bucs started Sha'Mya Leigh, Alyssia Faye, Carmella Walker, Sharita Godfrey, and Janaia Fargo once again.

The Bucs are coming off one of their best performances of the season as the Bucs shot 50.0% (21-of-42) from the floor and 74.1% (20-of-27) from the free throw line in an impressive 66-56 home win over Western Carolina. Carmella Walker (14), Janaia Fargo (13) and Sha'Mya Leigh (11) all recorded double-digit scoring in the win, while Alyssia Faye paced CSU's rebounding efforts with six more boards in the contest.

Highlighting the Returners

Charleston Southern returns nine players, including four starters from last season's squad as the Buccaneers look ahead to the 2020-21 season. Included in the mix are seniors Carmella

Walker and Kelsie Ruff, as well as veterans Anna Webster, Sharita Godfrey, and Alyssia Faye. The Bucs also welcome back a strong sophomore class that each saw valuable experience and strong playing time last season with Sha'Mya Leigh, Tyra Wright, Asia Smith, and Tori Gittens all ready to get back onto the court for their second go-round in the Blue & Gold.

Walker returns as CSU's leading scorer from the 2019-20 season as the New Smyrna Beach, Fla., native returns after scoring double-digits in a team-leading 15 games last year. Ruff returns as a multifaceted player that saw career-highs in points and steals last season. Godfrey took on a major scoring role last season with the Columbia, S.C., native posting 11 double-digit scoring games, including a career-high 22 points against High Point in January. Webster and Faye are both fighting to get back to the court as Webster is coming off a season-ending injury, while Faye will make her debut this year after transferring from Wichita State.

Leigh finished second on the team with 26 starts on the year, while tying for the team lead with 60 assists. Wright took over as Bucs' primary rebounder down the stretch last season, while Smith was the lone Buccaneer to earn conference Freshman of the Week recognition on the year. Gittens was one of the team's primary outside scoring threats and finished as the team's leading three-point scorer on the year.

Upperclassmen Leading the Way

Two years after a strong senior class that featured six players that saw significant time on the floor, the Bucs return a pair of experienced seniors, as well as three additional players that have spent at least two years in the collegiate game. All five athletes are expected to play significant roles in CSU's success both on and off the court in the 2020-21 season as the Bucs continue to blend their youth and experience. Walker reprises her veteran role in the backcourt as the rising senior returns with a team-high 28 starts in 2018-19, while leading the team in scoring and steals (64). She made an immediate impact in the CSU lineup from day one after transferring in from Daytona State College where she was a two-time All-Conference selection. Kelsie Ruff is one of two players entering their fourth season with the Buccaneers and saw major strides in her game where she posted eight double-digit scoring efforts, while tying for the team lead in assists (60) and free throw percentage (78.9%).

Webster was coming off her strongest offseason with the Bucs as the Four Oaks, N.C., native was expected to play valuable minutes for CSU before suffering a season-ending injury. She is a two-time Big South All-Academic selection and her veteran leadership nabbed her one of the three captain spots on the team this season. Godfrey provided major improvement across the board in the 2019-20 season in her first extended action on the court. She returns as CSU's second-leading scorer on the year and put together 11 double-

digit scoring games to go with a double-double on the year.

Faye is the wild card from the floor as the rising senior comes to the team after sitting out in 2019-20 following her transfer from Wichita State. Faye lined up in 58 of 61 games over her two seasons at WSU and has extensive playing experience overseas. The Valence, France, native was selected to the French National U-20 team and averaged 12.6 points and 8.8 rebounds during her season on the squad.

Sophomore Strong

One of the benefits to having a large graduating class in the 2018-19 season was the rapid development and amount of playing time afforded to the 2019-20 freshman class. All four returning sophomores boasted multiple starts last season paced by guard and 2020-21 captain Sha'Mya Leigh, while Tyra Wright, Tori Gittens, and Asia Smith sat among the shooting and rebounding leaders for the team last season.

Leigh scored double-digits in two of her first six games on the court with the Bucs and finished among CSU's assist and steal leaders last year. The Dayton, Ohio, native averaged nearly 30 minutes playing time on the court on her way to averaging 5.4 points per game and over two assists per contest. Wright boasted a trio of double-digit scoring games, including her first collegiate double-double against USC Upstate in early February and will be counted on to bolster

CSU's inside scoring game this year.

Gittens spotted up with 11 starts in the 2019-20 season and put together a pair of multi-three-point scoring games last season. The Sherman, Texas, native scored double-digits in just her second collegiate game against South Carolina State, and added double-digit efforts in conference play against Upstate, Longwood, and Gardner-Webb. Smith highlighted the group prior to the holiday break in earning Big South Freshman of the Week honors following her performances against Western Carolina and Virginia-Lynchburg. She showcased her ability to score and rebound throughout the season on her way to finishing among the Bucs' rebounding leaders by the end of the year.

Transfers Making the Jump

For the second consecutive season, the Buccaneers turned to the transfer portal to bolster the roster with veteran leadership and scoring. After welcoming Walker and Faye to the roster last season, the Bucs welcome to the floor this season Jamya Rogers (Walters State).

Rogers started 51 times at Walters State and averaged 13.8 points per game on 54.8% shooting in her sophomore season. She posted at least 20 points scoring in six different games, including back-to-back 23-point efforts in her final two contests.

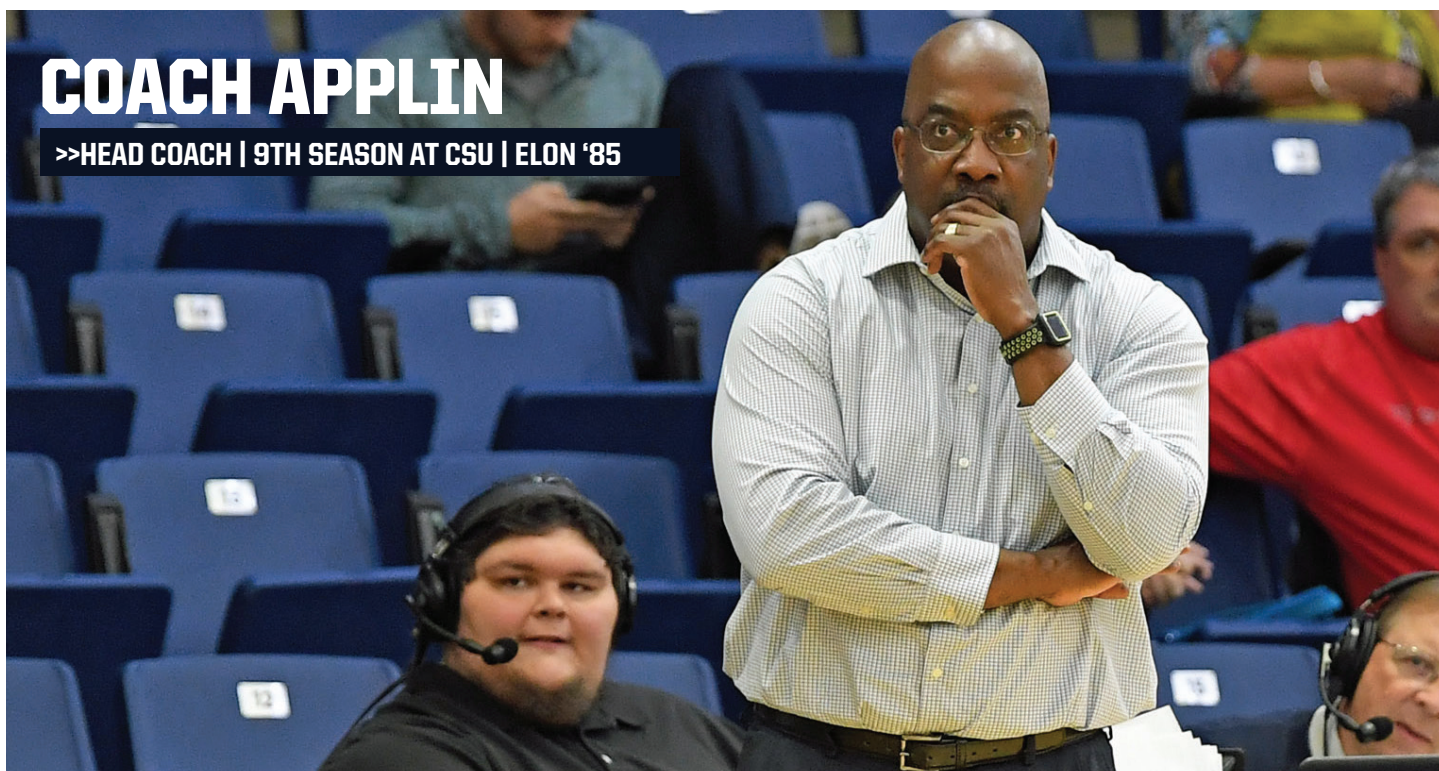

Fred Applin wrapped up his seventh season as the head coach of the CSU women's basketball team after assuming the mantle of the 15th coach in program history in 2012 after serving as an assistant with East Carolina. CSU is the second head coaching position for Applin after serving as the bench boss at Big South newcomer Hampton from 1995-97. Applin also brings plenty of coaching experience at the Power 5 level to CSU with time at North Carolina, Wake Forest, Texas and Washington in the ACC, Big 12 and Pac-12.

During his time at CSU, Applin has led the Bucs to the Big South semifinals in 2017 and 2019 - as well as an appearance in the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI). He enters the 2019-20 season with four-straight 10-win seasons and tied the program record for single-season wins with 18 two seasons ago. CSU also has won a Big South Conference Tournament game each of the last three seasons - a feat they haven't accomplished since collecting wins in five-straight tournaments between 1998 and 2002.

The Bucs have also garnered numerous Big South accolades under Applin's guidance with eight total athletes - Lakeitha Alston, Erin Bratcher, Alyssa Mann, Ke'Asia Jackson, Anna Webster, Kirklin Kirkpatrick, Carra Coy and Tatum Jarvis - receiving recognition.

Applin boasts an impressive resume with experience in the ACC, Big 12, Pac 12 and Conference USA. He arrives in Charleston after spending two seasons in Greenville, N.C., where he was an assistant under head coach Heather Macy at East Carolina University. Applin served as the recruiting coordinator for the Pirates, corresponding with potential student-athletes, parents and high school and AAU coaches. He also assisted in all areas of the program, including scouting, coaching, academic support and game preparation.

A member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, the WBCA and Black Coaches' Association, Applin dedicates time to his teams' academic and community service efforts as well. Two of his teams in particular - ECU and Hampton - have been honored for their work in the classroom, as both teams boasted the highest team GPAs in respective program histories during Applin's tenure.

A 1985 graduate of Elon College, Applin competed in both football and track & field for the Phoenix and was a member of the NAIA National Championship football team. He went on to earn his master's degree in therapeutic recreation from North Carolina Central University in 1989. Applin and wife Cora have three children; daughters Anaiah and Hillary and son Michael.
