#12 – ALYSSA SWEENEY**2019-20 - SOPHOMORE SEASON**

Played in 20 games for the Lady Pirates...finished the season with 29 points, and 10 rebounds...she had a single game season high of nine points and three rebounds against Mount St. Mary's Dec. 19, 2019.

2018-19- FRESHMAN SEASON

Played in 23 games for the Lady Pirates, making her lone start against Presbyterian College... averaged 4.0 points and 0.8 rebounds per contest...she shot 35.4 % from behind the arc and was 71.4 % from the line...she had a season high of 24 points against Mid-Atlantic Christian and recorded a single game high of six three pointers...She recorded 20 points and three rebounds and went 8-of-12 shooting and 4 of 7 from deep against Longwood February 23.

Had six 20+ points games and recorded 10 double doubles on the season...Had a season high of 30 points against Longwood...she finished 1st in

rebounds, and 3rd in scoring on the team. She landed 11th in scoring with (12.7 ppg), tied for 10th in blocked shots (0.8 bpg) and 7th in rebounds (7.1 rpg) in the Big South Conference...she earned All-Freshman Team... played a total of 860 minutes...finished the season with 369 points, 42 steals, 16 assists, and 206 rebounds.
